

THE BIG EASY SCRAMBLE 2025

Date Start Format of Play Courses Tees	 Saturday, 22nd February 2025 1.30pm – Shotgun Strokeplay – Two Man Scramble Golf Valley Course Silver Tees (Men's Tee) Jade Tees (Ladies Tee)
Novelty	: Longest Drive - Hole 10 Nearest to Line - Hole 8 Nearest To Pin - Hole 17 Bullseye - Hole 17
Entrance Fee	: RM 200 per person (Privilege Pass Holders) RM 420 per person (Guests)

RULES OF COMPETITION

- 1. A scramble means that both team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker.
- 2. The other team member picks up his/her ball and places it within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Each team member hits their next shot from the chosen spot of the prior shot.
- 3. This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts. The ball should be marked on the putting green also.
- 4. Putts need to be made within 3 inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). The first ball to go in the hole is counted as the team score. When putting, once any ball is holed out, no further strokes count. The team is cautioned not to make "tap" in putt until both team members have had the opportunity to attempt the team's original putt.
- 5. Each player's tee shot must be used at least six times during the 18-hole competition.
- 6. Men tee off from the silver tees and women from the jade tees.
- 7. Team Handicap will be calculated in the following manner.

TEAM's handicap for the day is calculated as follows: (Handicap Indexes to be converted to Course Handicap before calculation)

E.g.: Player A's Handicap = 20 & Player B's Handicap = 14 35% of the Lower handicap + 15% of Higher handicap = 4.9 + 3 = 7.9 Team handicap will be 7.9 Gross Score 81 Nett Score 81 - 7.9 = 73.1 (Team Score)

- 8. Should there be ties, the OCB will apply as follows: -
 - Last 9 Holes
 - Last 6 Holes
 - Last 3 Holes
 - Last Hole
 - By Lot
